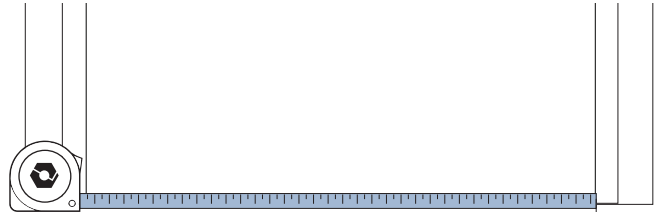




**Adjustable - Aluminum - Bronze - Carpet Saddles - Half Saddles - Interlocking - Expansion Joint - Solid Rubber - Thermal Break - Stainless Steel - Rubber Grip - Rabbeted - Ramps - Diamond Plate**

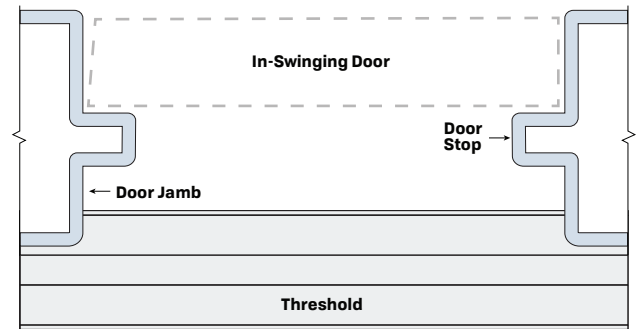
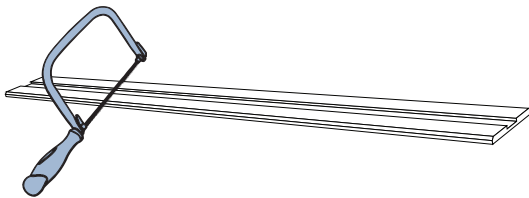
**1. Measure**

Measure the door sill (frame width at bottom) and cut the threshold to extend the full width of the opening.



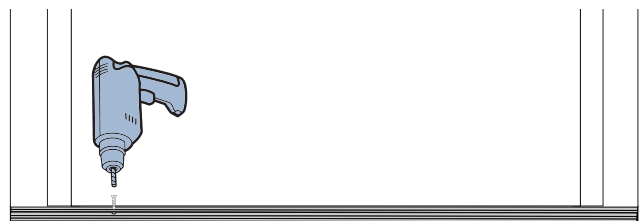
**2. Cut**

Notch the threshold sides if necessary to accommodate the side jamb stops. Shim the saddle if needed and make sure that it is completely level.



**3. Secure**

Fasten the threshold to the sill with screws provided.



**4. Examine**

Operate the door several times to ensure the part is properly adjusted so as not to inhibit the door from self-closing and latching.

**5. Caulk**

Caulk around base of saddle for increased moisture control.
